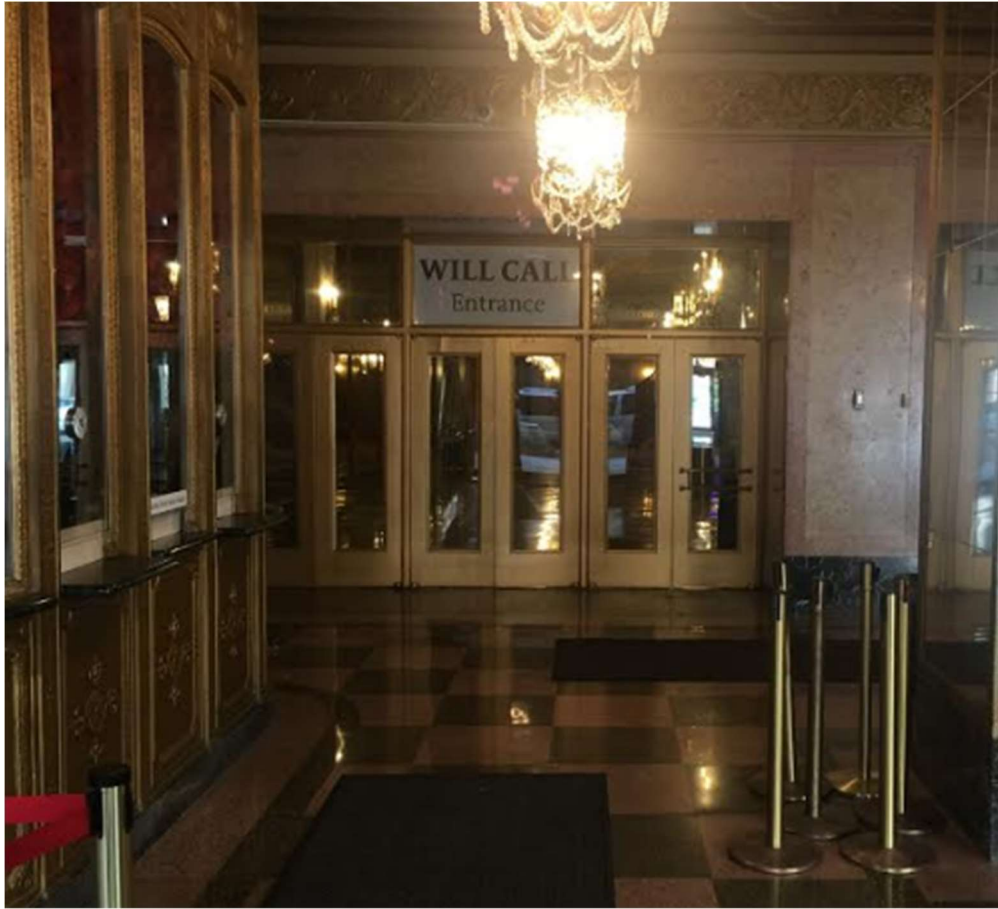




I am going to the Orpheum Theatre where I will see AIR PLAY. During the show I will hear music and see lots of lights and balloons!
